3) Diploma for the highest level & Transcript	* Diploma and Transcript need to be translated into English or Korean. * Transcript should include all records by each grade. * A student which belongs to the below 21 countries should submit by email an original diploma and transcript confirmed by the Korean consulate or Apostille. * 21 countries: China, Philippines, Indonesia, Bangladesh, Vietnam, Mongolia, Thailand, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, India, Myanmar, Nepal, Iran, Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Ukraine, Nigeria, Ghana, Egypt, Peru
4) Original certificate of bank balances in English	* The Balance must be over 9,000USD and be indicated officially in USD by the relevant bank. * Certificate should be issued within one month from now.
5) Passport copy	* A copy of the photo page in your passport
6) Family Certificate or Birth Certificate	* Indicating all family members' name in English
